### ORDER

(Directing Parties to File Legal Memoranda on Newly Acquired Powertech Data)

Contention 3 in the above captioned proceeding concerns a challenge that the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FSEIS) failed to include adequate hydrogeological information to demonstrate the ability to contain fluid migration. On August 6, 2014 the Board asked applicant Powertech to address when its newly acquired data, referenced in exhibit OST-019, and appearing relevant to Contention 3, would be disclosed to the parties.<sup>1</sup> Powertech's response requested clarification on the type of response required, and stated that Powertech believed the Board would benefit from legal argument from all parties on this issue.<sup>2</sup>

The Board now directs all parties to this proceeding to file legal memoranda on two issues. First, addressing the relevance of the newly acquired data<sup>3</sup> to Contention 3 and second, whether the data is subject to mandatory disclosure in this proceeding as defined in 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(a).

Regardless of the outcome following this legal briefing the Evidentiary Hearing scheduled to begin Tuesday, August 19 in Rapid City, SD will begin on time and will proceed on all the issues within each contention scheduled to be heard.

The Board directs the parties to file their memoranda through the NRC's EIE system or by email if email filing was previously granted in this proceeding.<sup>4</sup>
