<u>NOTICE</u> (Regarding Expected Issuance of Initial Decision)

The Board hereby notifies the Commission and the parties of the status of its Initial

Decision for this proceeding. Although the Board's Order establishing filing dates did not

include a specific date for issuance of the Initial Decision,¹ the Board intended to issue the Initial

Decision within 90 days of the closing of the record.² After the Board resolved all matters

related to the content of the adjudicatory record, the Board closed the record on December 10,

2014³ which set the projected issuance of the Initial Decision as March 10, 2015.⁴ The Board
