Dear Mr. Blubaugh:

Enclosed are the UIC Class V Draft Permit and the Public Notice for the Class V injection well that will be used to reinject groundwater pumped from the Upper Fox Hills Formation back into the same formation from which it was pumped. The Statement of Basis, which is a detailed discussion of technical issues EPA considered during the development of the Draft Permit, is also enclosed.

The public notice will be published in the *Greeley Tribune*, notifying the public of their opportunity to comment on this permit action. The public notice also announces a public hearing that will be held at the Island Grove 4-H Building located at 527 North 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Greeley at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 20, 2009. The public comment period for this action will end on July 24, 2009.

The enclosed Draft Permit and Statement of Basis are being sent to you so that you also may have the opportunity to comment on the Draft Permit during the comment period.

The enclosed permit is a "**DRAFT**" version of the proposed Final Permit. It is an example of what the Final Permit will look like, and is being sent to you for your review and comment. This version of the Permit is **NOT** official.

Please be aware that a Final Permit decision will not be made until after the public comment period closes. EPA will consider all comments received during the public comment period and during the public hearing before making a Final Permit decision. If no comments request a change in the draft permit, the permit shall become effective immediately upon issuance. If comments request a change, then the effective date of the Final Permit will be an

additional thirty (30) days after the issuance date. This delay is required by Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Section 124.15 (b) in order to allow for a potential appeal of the Final Permit.
