The NRC Staff moves for the Board to admit Exhibit NRC-171-R into evidence. On October 14, 2014, the Staff submitted Exhibit NRC-171. The second (bottom) figure in Exhibit NRC-171 was supposed to show the elevations in a section of the Dewey-Burdock site. The Staff later realized, however, that the second figure in Exhibit NRC-171 does not list the elevations along its contour lines. To correct this, the Staff offers a revised exhibit, NRC-171-R. This exhibit is the same as the prior exhibit, except that the second figure lists elevations.

The Staff consulted with the other parties to obtain their views on this motion. Each party stated that it does not object to the motion.
