Subject: Medical Society Opposition to Uranium Mining

To the Wellington Board of Trustees:

I am unable to attend the Wellington Board of Trustees meeting to represent the Medical Society (it's my sons birthday). I ask you consider that both the Larimer County Medial Society (LCMS) and the Colorado Medical Society (CMS) have gone on record opposing the uranium mining proposed outside Wellington and Fort Collins (Northern Colorado Centennial Project).

Attached are documents from the LCMS (letter and resolution) that I would offer to be introduced/read at your Board of Trustees meeting. The resolution passed last year when I was president.

I assume you are aware of the recent problems from the Smith-Highland Ranch in-situ leach uranium mine in Wyoming. What has been considered Wyoming's "model" in-situ uranium mine, and the only operational uranium facility in the state in recent years, is under scrutiny by state regulators for what they describe as an alarming volume of environmental violations.
