If it comes through, there would be business of 1.3 million dollars annually with NFC," M W Mining's president Wallace M Mays said here today on the sidelines of a Indo-US business meet.</p> <p>"The 500 metric tonnes of uranium (in the form of uranium oxide) will be supplied for two indigenous pressurised heavy water reactors for five years," he said.</p> <p>"Negotiations are on over pricing and it will not be made public at present. But I am sure it would be beneficial for both parties," Mays said.</p> <p>Mays is part of a delegation of representatives of top US nuclear firms that is in India to explore possibilities for trade in the atomic field.</p> <p>The US House of Representatives and the Senate have passed two separate Bills to implement the Indo-US civil nuclear deal.
